### **VIJAY 2019**

Excellence in academics is the hallmark of our institution and the class X and XII results of the school prove without an iota of doubt that our students have made us proud. The key highlights are:

- 100% results
- 93% of students have scored 80% and above.
- 12 students scored A1 in all subjects. Our students scored 100 marks in mathematics, Social Science, and Science .
- Joseph Sebastian was the school topper achieving 98.6% with A1 grade in all subjects securing 100 marks in Science and SS
- In All India Senior School Certificate Examination March 2019, **Jobin Philip James** of Science stream and **Anu Sabu** from commerce Stream are the toppers with an impressive score of 95.6% and 94.4% respectively. **Sneha Annie Robert** and **Anu Sabu** secured A1 in all subjects.
